NINE LAMP

Materials: Thai Puan Tin Chok cotton, Teak wood, polypropylene, ceramic hardware.
40cm x 12cm - 20cm x25cm

Ancient patterns of the Thai Puan tribe are proudly on display in this set of lamps that represent knowledge passed down through the generations to present day. Each piece is brought to life by our expert weavers producing mesmerizing patterns using vibrant traditional colors.

THREADS LAMP

Materials: Natural dye cotton,
mahogany wood, stainless steel,
ceramic hardware.

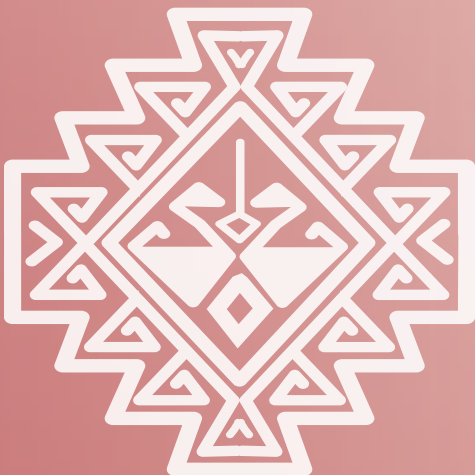
Suspension lamp that highlights our handwoven process showcasing the combination of individual cotton threads and transforming them into wonderful layers of natural dye fabric.



JOK PHUAN FRAMES

Material: Teak wood, Tin Chok cotton.
30cm x 30cm

Drawing inspiration from nature, elements such as birds, fish and flowers depict the nine ancient patterns of the Thai Puan heritage. Beautifully framed and handmade, each piece of art is as unique as a pearl in the sea.







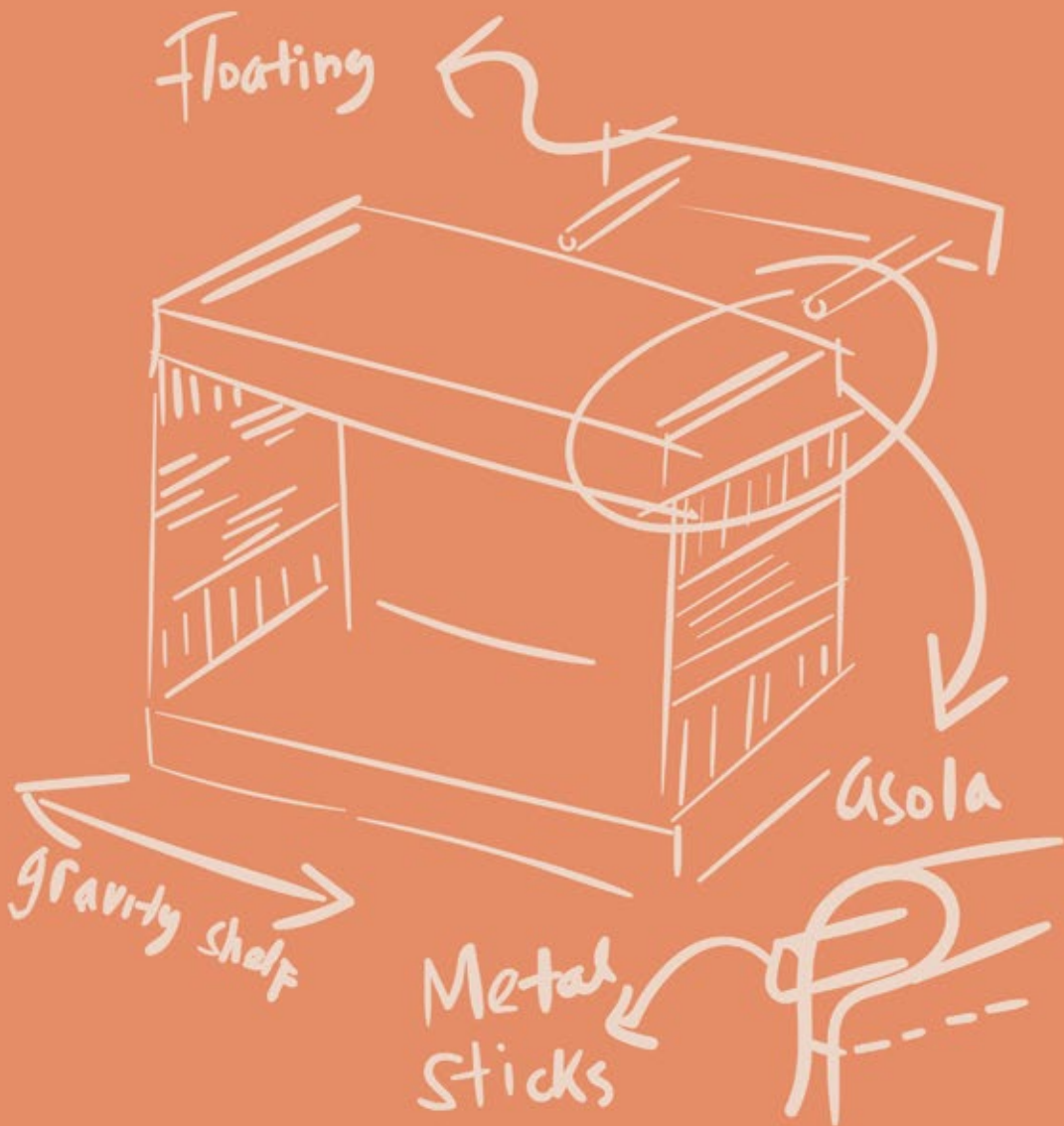


LOOM ARMCHAIR

Materials: Teak wood, ken weaved cotton.

Antique meets contemporary with this classic armchair design. The flow of fabric through the loom, movement of the weavers and experienced guiding hands gives birth to this latest textile design combined with abstract elements from ancient motifs.





SI LA LENG SHELVES

Materials: Hand waved cotton, Teak wood, stainless steel.

Floating shelf held by fabric. Inspired by stones used for construction during ancient times and found in historical parks throughout Thailand. The fabric displays the transition from threads of cotton to woven cotton.



MAT-JOK CARPETS

Materials: Cotton 120cm x 65cm

These carpets are a fusion of two weaving techniques, one consist of tie-dying the threads to create the pattern and set the colours of the body.

The second one belongs to the ancient Tin-Jok technique, the borders of the carpet depicts one motif also present on the Thai Phuan sarong, it figures the flowers which in the tribe iconography have the function to soften the look of the rich weaved fabrics.
